

**We are planning a recce tour to the Land Of The Midnight Sun.**



Come and join us in the most northern region of Norway, Finnmark, for one of the most spectacular sights in the birding year in Europe. We are travelling to Varanger Peninsular where we will stay for 5 nights to see, not only the millions of breeding seabirds on the steep cliffs of the northern coastline bordering the Arctic Ocean, but also the tundra birds of the central region which is dominated by mires and moors. Veranga has the highest density of arctic and tundra birds in mainland Europe.

On the Peninsular we will look for Red-Necked Phalarope, Harlequin Duck, Spectacled Eider, Great Spotted Eagle, Semipalmated Plover, Short-tailed Dowitcher, Stilt Sandpiper, Buff-Bellied Pipit, and of course White-Tailed Eagle amongst the many arctic waders, skuas and auks.
